What is History?	History is the study of the past. The goal of history is to understand how the past has made the present.
How do historians know about the past?	Primary Sources are the original or first source. This includes: Diaries, Photographs, Autobiographies, eyewitness accounts, and artifacts.
	Secondary Sources are sources that get their information from the primary source.
	Examples: Encyclopedias, Wikipedia, Biographies, book reports, summaries.
Interpretation	Historians sometimes have to be detectives and interpret information they find. For example, if they find ancient human remains in Minnesota with a seashell from Florida, they could interpret that these ancient Minnesotans had a trade network.
