<p>What should Maps have?</p>	<p>TODALSS</p> <p>T is for Title of the map</p> <p>O is for Orientation on a map (Compass Rose)</p> <p>D is for the Date when the map was made</p> <p>A is for Author of the map</p> <p>L is for Legend of the map (shows what the symbols mean on the map)</p> <p>S is for scale on the map (how far apart places are)</p> <p>S is for Source. (Where did the map come from? Wikipedia? Textbook?)</p>
